Rules for the CNY USBC Association's Youth City Tournament

Instructions:

All ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY January 2, 2026 TO BE GUARANTEED A SPOT. Walk ins will be permitted only if there is room!

Doubles/Singles are 2 sets of 3 games one set right after another for a total of 6 games. You must bowl both doubles and singles. Please be sure that when you fill out the front, that you include all of the information and that you have read these rules and information thoroughly. Please make an X next to the person who is your team captain.

Rules:

- 1. Bowlers must be USBC certified, eligible participants who are not USBC members can qualify by paying their dues of \$12.
- 2. Handicaps will be based on 90% of 200.
- 3. Entering Average:
 - a. Highest current USBC Youth league average, minimum of 12 games as of 1/1/26 (a standing sheet showing your USBC youth average will be proof of your average)
 - b. If no current season average, use previous season USBC youth average, minimum 12 games.
 - c. Bowlers without a minimum of 12 games USBC Youth Average must bowl scratch.
- 4. Team captain must list bowlers in the order that they bowl.
- 5. Substitutes must bowl in the position of the bowler they are replacing.
- 6. Entrants are not permitted to eat or drink in the settee area. All food and beverages must be at the tables provided.
- 7. ADULTS: No alcoholic beverages are allowed where the bowlers are. Please keep it in the bar area.
- 8. No confirmation sent.
- 9. The Tournament Directors shall decide any stipulations not covered by these rules.
- 10. A dress code shall be enforced; you may wear jeans, shorts, leggings or pants with collared shirt or T-shirt. No short shorts or short skirts. No inappropriate sayings or hole in your clothing.
- 11. The USBC rulebook will govern all rules not written here.
- 12. Final results will be posted on the Central New York USBC Association's Facebook page & on our website www.cnyusbcbowling.com Winners will receive a letter in the mail.
